The 14th Annual 2025 NYC C3 SUMMIT DAVOS OF HEALTHCARE™ will be Keynoted by General David Petraeus. Since the C3 Summit was inaugurated in 2012 by President Bill Clinton, other notable keynote speakers have included Secretary of State Dr. Henry Kissinger, General Wesley Clark, Ambassador Terry Branstad, former Ambassador of the United States to China, who inaugurated the first C3 China Summit in Beijing in 2019. C3 also has featured global dignitaries including Ambassador Dr. Deborah Birx, White House, Coronavirus Task Force, HRH Princess Reema bint Bandar bin Sultan bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, Saudi Arabia's first female Ambassador to the United States and scores of Ambassadors and Fortune 500 Chieftains and industry giants in the healthcare field such as H.E. Dr. Majid Al Fayyadh, Chief Executive Officer of King Faisal Specialist Hospital and Research Centre (KFSHRC), the leading healthcare provider in the Middle East.
